A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO COMPLETE RENOVATION OF THE
2 CHEATHAM BUILDING, OLD ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, AND OTHER
3 SIGNIFICANT HISTORICAL LANDMARKS THAT COMPRISE THE CAMPUS
4 OF THE CENTRAL CHILDREN'S HOME, INC.

6 Whereas, the Central Children's Home of North Carolina continues to provide
7 residential care services for many of North Carolina's less fortunate children who are
8 neglected, dependent, or orphaned, regardless of their race, creed, or color; and

9 Whereas, the Board of Directors continue to diligently improve the residential
10 environment for the children currently living at the Central Children's home by
11 spending thousands of dollars via private funding resources to maintain the up-keep of
12 its physical plant operations; and

13 Whereas, the Cheatham Building and other historical landmarks which
14 comprise the campus of the Central Children's Home were recently nominated for the
15 National Register of Historic Places; and

16 Whereas, it is in the best interest of all citizens of North Carolina to protect
17 and preserve its historical places and landmarks; Now, therefore,
18 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

19 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
20 Cultural Resources, Division of Archives and History, the sum of one hundred twenty-
21 nine thousand seven hundred thirty dollars (\$129,730) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to
22 complete the renovation of the Cheatham Building, Old Administration Building, and
23 other significant historical landmarks that comprise the campus of the Central Children's
24 Home, Inc., in Oxford.

1 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
