G.S. 14-118.5(f) reads as rewritten: "(f) The receipt, decoding or converting of a signal from the air by the use of a satellite dish or antenna shall not constitute a violation of this section. The receipt, decoding, or converting of a signal by converting additional reception devices or outlets within a subscriber's residence shall not constitute a violation of this section." Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
