1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT AN EMPLOYEE IS NOT DISQUALIFIED FOR
3 UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS WHEN THE EMPLOYER FILES FOR
4 BANKRUPTCY.
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6 Section 1. G.S. 96-14 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7 "(12) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter, no otherwise
8 eligible individual shall be denied benefits for any weeks if it is
9 determined by the Commission that such individual is, at the time such
10 claim is filed, unemployed because he left work solely as a result of a
11 lack of work caused by the bankruptcy of his employer."
12 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
