A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A VIET NAM VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Transportation the sum of six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to establish a Viet Nam Veterans Memorial Park on Interstate 85, provided that local funds are raised to match this appropriation on the basis of one dollar (\$1.00) of local funds for every two dollars (\$2.00) of State funds. Contributions of property or services as well as cash may be used as a match.

Sec. 2. G.S. 143-31.4 does not apply to this appropriation.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
