A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT FIVE EASTERN REGIONAL  
MENTAL HEALTH, MENTAL RETARDATION, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE  
CENTERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Mental Health, Mental Retardation, and Substance Abuse Services \$2,051,571 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses of five eastern regional mental health, mental retardation, and substance abuse centers, to be allocated based on need among the following:

- (1) Tideland Mental Health, Mental Retardation, and Substance Abuse Program;
- (2) Roanoke-Chowan Human Services Center for Mental Health, Mental Retardation, and Substance Abuse;
- (3) Southeastern Mental Health, Mental Retardation, and Substance Abuse Program;
- (4) Onslow Mental Health, Mental Retardation, and Substance Abuse Program; and
- (5) Pitt County Mental Health, Mental Retardation, and Substance Abuse Program.

Sec. 2. Funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act shall become part of the Department of Human Resources' continuation budget.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
