April 11, 1991 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ALLOW COUNTIES IN WHICH THERE ARE HIGHWAY TRUST FUND PROJECTS TO DIVERT SOME OF THE FUNDS FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The governing body or bodies of any county or counties in which there are planned highway trust fund projects may elect to have the funds to be spent on those projects spent on public transportation services such as light rail service or expanded Amtrak services. The governing body of each county in which the project was planned must make this election by a resolution, duly passed, and forwarded to the Department of Transportation.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
