A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A STATE PARK ON THE MAYO RIVER IN ROCKINGHAM COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of \$35,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year to conduct a study of the feasibility of establishing a State park on the Mayo River in Rockingham County.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
