1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE EXCISE TAX ON CIGARETTES FROM TWO 3 CENTS PER PACK TO SEVEN CENTS PER PACK.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 105-113.5 reads as rewritten:

"§ 105-113.5. Privilege tax levied.

In addition to all other taxes and fees, a tax is hereby levied upon the sale or possession for sale within this State, by distributors, of all cigarettes at the rate of one mill-three and one-half mills per individual cigarette.

The tax hereby levied shall not apply to free distribution of sample cigarettes in packages containing five or fewer cigarettes nor to any package of cigarettes customarily donated free of charge by manufacturers of cigarettes to employees in factories where cigarettes are manufactured in this State where such packages of cigarettes are not taxed by the federal government."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
