A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SPECIALIZED PLATES FOR VIETNAM VETERANS. 2 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 4 5 section to read: "§ 20-81.12. Vietnam veteran plates. 6 The Commissioner shall cause to be made a sufficient number of distinctive 7 (a) motor vehicle license plates for issuance to eligible persons who make application on a 8 9 form designated by the Division and supply documentation that they were members of the Uniformed Services of the United States and served in the Vietnam War. Upon 10 satisfactory proof of eligibility, the Commissioner shall collect a fee in an amount equal 11 to the applicable fee under G.S. 20-87 plus ten dollars (\$10.00). The additional fee 12 imposed by this section shall be credited to the Personalized Registration Plate Fund. 13 The distinctive plates required by subsection (a) of this section shall bear the (b) 14 words 'Vietnam Veteran' across the top of the plate and shall also bear the insignia of 15 the Vietnam Veterans of America. The license plates shall be numbered sequentially 16 beginning with the number 001. These license plates shall be issued based on the date 17 18 of receipt of the applications by the Division."
