A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	AN ACT TO FUND THE MILK SANITATION INSPECTION PROGRAM.
3	Whereas, it is in the interest of the public health and a requirement of federal
4	public health law to maintain inspections of Grade A milk produced, transported, and
5	distributed from and within this State; and
6	Whereas, limited local resources have caused a decrease in the number of
7	local health departments that assume responsibility for Grade A milk inspections; and
8	Whereas, the decrease in local responsibility for inspections has increased the
9	burden on the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources to ensure that
10	all inspections are made; Now, therefore,
11	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
12	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Milk
13	Sanitation Inspection Program of the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural
14	Resources the sum of \$251,463 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$251,463 for
15	the 1992-93 fiscal year for personnel costs for the Milk Sanitation Inspection Program.
16	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
