AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH AN OFFICE OF MINORITY

HEALTH AND A MINORITY HEALTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE WITHIN

THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND NATURAL

RESOURCES.

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of \$85,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$105,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to establish and support an Office of Minority Health and a Minority Health Advisory Committee within the Department. These entities shall operate together and in cooperation with other State, local, and private organizations to identify and document the causes of the profound gap in health status between white and nonwhite citizens of North Carolina, and to develop and advocate alterations and expansions in health programs and services designed to eradicate this gap.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
