Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of \$100,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$100,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the North Carolina 4-H Development Fund at North Carolina State University for camp operation funds for the North Carolina 4-H Camp Program.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
