A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA 4-H
2 PROGRAM.

4 Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H Camps are owned by the State, or deeded to
5 an entity of the State, North Carolina State University; and

6 Whereas, no appropriated funds presently are allocated for the maintenance of
7 these facilities; and

8 Whereas, those facilities provide educational and recreational services to
9 more than 10,000 North Carolina families each year representative of the State
10 population; and

11 Whereas, these properties represent capital assets of more than \$7,000,000
12 contributed by citizen volunteers; Now, therefore,
13 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

14 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
15 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of \$100,000 for the 1991-92
16 fiscal year and the sum of \$100,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the North Carolina 4-
17 H Development Fund at North Carolina State University for camp operation funds for
18 the North Carolina 4-H Camp Program.

19 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
