Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the impact on administration and service delivery of the Health Divisions resulting from moving the Health Divisions from the Department of Human Resources to the newly created Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources. The Commission may also study the advantages that may be gained by placing the Health Divisions of the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources under the Department of Human Resources. The Legislative Research Commission may report its findings, together with recommended legislation, to the 1992 Session of the 1991 General Assembly, to the 1993 General Assembly, or to both.
