The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to study ways the State could encourage minorities to visit the State for the purposes of tourism, conferences, and conventions. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report of the results of its study to the 1992 Regular Session of the 1991 General Assembly and a final report to the 1993 General Assembly.
