2 AN ACT TO INCLUDE RESCUE SQUAD AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL  
3 SERVICES WORKERS WITHIN THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR  
4 COUNTIES, CITIES, AND TOWNS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 128-21(10) reads as rewritten:

7 "(10) 'Employee' shall mean any person who is regularly employed in the  
8 service of and whose salary or compensation is paid by the employer  
9 as defined in subdivision (11) of this section, including employees of  
10 any light and water board or commission, and full-time employees of  
11 any housing authority created and operating under and by virtue of  
12 Chapter 157 of the General Statutes, whether employed or appointed  
13 for stated terms or otherwise, except teachers in the public schools and  
14 except such employees who hold office by popular election as are not  
15 required to devote a major portion of their time to the duties of their  
16 office. 'Employee' shall also mean all full-time, paid ~~firemen~~firemen,  
17 rescue, or emergency medical services workers who are employed by  
18 any fire ~~department~~department, rescue squad, or emergency medical  
19 service that serves a city or county or any part thereof and that is  
20 supported in whole or in part by municipal or county funds. In all  
21 cases of doubt the Board of Trustees shall decide who is an employee."

22 Sec. 2. G.S. 128-21(11) reads as rewritten:

23 "(11) 'Employer' shall mean any county, incorporated city or town, the light  
24 and water board or commission of any incorporated city or town, the

1 board of alcoholic control of any county or incorporated city or town,  
2 the North Carolina League of Municipalities, the State Association of  
3 County Commissioners, county and/or city airport authorities, housing  
4 authorities created and operated under and by virtue of Chapter 157 of  
5 the General Statutes, redevelopment commissions created and operated  
6 under and by virtue of Article 37, Chapter 160 of the General Statutes,  
7 county and/or city or regional libraries, county and/or city boards of  
8 health, district boards of health, any other separate, local governmental  
9 entity, and the Retirement System. 'Employer' shall also mean any fire  
10 ~~department~~ department, rescue squad, or emergency medical service  
11 that serves a city or county or any part thereof, and that is supported in  
12 whole or in part by municipal or county funds."

13 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
