A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM TO PASS AN
ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION OF MALT BEVERAGES OR
UNFORTIFIED WINE ON PUBLIC PROPERTY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 18B-300(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) Local Ordinance. – A city or county may by ordinance regulate the consumption or possession of malt beverages and unfortified wine on property owned or occupied by that city or county."

Sec. 2. This act applies only to the City of Winston-Salem.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
