AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO ADOPT RULES TO IMPLEMENT THE NORTH CAROLINA ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT OF 1971 AND OF STATE AGENCIES TO ADOPT RULES ESTABLISHING MINIMUM CRITERIA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 1 of Chapter 113A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 113A-11. Adoption of rules.

- The Department of Administration shall adopt rules to implement this Article. (a)
- Each State agency may adopt rules that establish minimum criteria. (b) Minimum criteria specify particular actions or classes of actions for which the preparation of the detailed statement described in G.S. 113A-4(2) is not required. An agency may include a particular action or class of actions in its minimum criteria only if the agency makes a specific finding that the action or class of actions has no significant impact on the environment. Rules establishing minimum criteria shall be consistent with rules adopted by the Department of Administration. In addition to all other rulemaking requirements, rules establishing minimum criteria are subject to approval by the Secretary of Administration."
