A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE OUTDOOR HISTORICAL
DRAMA, "PASSAGE TO FREEDOM".

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Snow Camp Historical Drama Society, Inc., of Alamance County the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year to fund the new outdoor historical drama, "Passage to Freedom" to be produced alternately with the outdoor drama "Sword of Peace". This new outdoor drama is based on the Quaker participation in what has been termed the "underground railroad" before and during the Civil War.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
