A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REMOVE CERTAIN UNIVERSITIES FROM THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE PURCHASE STUDENT ACCIDENT AND HEALTH POLICIES FOR ALL AGENCIES AND DEPARTMENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 58-31-55 reads as rewritten:

"§ 58-31-55. Insurance and official fidelity bonds for State agencies to be placed by Department; exception; costs of placement.

Except as provided in G.S. 58-32-15, all insurance and all official fidelity and surety bonds authorized for State departments, institutions, and agencies shall be effected and placed by the Department, and the cost of such placement shall be paid by the Department, institution, or agency involved upon bills rendered to and approved by the Commissioner. This section shall not apply to student accident and health insurance at Winston-Salem State University, Fayetteville State University, North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University, and Elizabeth City State University."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
