A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE STANLY COUNTY AIRPORT AUTHORITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 419, Session Laws of 1971, as amended by Chapter 238, Session Laws of 1983, and as further amended by Chapter 929 of the 1987 Session Laws reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 2. The Airport Authority shall consist of ~~six~~five members who shall be appointed to staggered terms of four years by the Stanly County Board of Commissioners. All of the members shall be residents of the County. The terms of the ~~five~~four appointed members of the Airport Authority shall be as follows: two members serving terms expiring March 31, ~~1989~~1993 and ~~three~~two members serving terms expiring March 31, ~~1991~~1995. Thereafter, all terms shall be for four years. Each of the members and their successors so appointed shall take and subscribe before the Clerk of the Superior Court of Stanly County, an oath of office and file same with the Stanly County Board of Commissioners. Upon the occurrence of any vacancy on said Airport Authority, said vacancy shall be filled within 60 days after notice thereof at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners. One of the ~~six~~five members shall be a county commissioner, whose term on the Airport Authority shall run concurrently with that member's term as county commissioner. In the case of the member of the Stanly County Board of Commissioners serving as a voting member of the said Airport Authority, such membership shall not constitute double office holding within the meaning of Article VI, Sec. 9 of the Constitution of North Carolina, but instead is service ex officio."

1           Sec. 2. This act becomes effective April 1, 1991.
