Short Title: Pharmacy Board Fees.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO CHANGE CERTAIN FEES CHARGED BY THE BOARD OF
3 PHARMACY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 90-85.24 reads as rewritten:

6 "**§ 90-85.24. Fees collectible by Board.**

7 The Board of Pharmacy shall be entitled to charge and collect not more than the
8 following fees: for the examination of an applicant for license as a pharmacist, one
9 hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) plus the cost of the test material; for renewing the
10 license as a pharmacist, sixty-five dollars (\$65.00); for renewing the license of an
11 assistant pharmacist, ten dollars (\$10.00); for licenses without examination as provided
12 in G.S. 90-85.20, original, three hundred dollars (\$300.00); for original registration of a
13 ~~drugstore, pharmacy or other dispensing site,~~ two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), and
14 renewal thereof, one hundred twenty-five dollars ~~(\$125.00).~~ ~~(\$125.00); for the~~
15 registration of a dispensing physician, original, fifty dollars (\$50.00), renewal thereof,
16 ten dollars (\$10.00); for annual registration as a dispensing physician assistant,
17 dispensing family nurse practitioner and others not otherwise licensed who dispense
18 prescriptions, ten dollars (\$10.00); for registration of places engaged in dispensing
19 devices as provided in G.S. 90-85.22, original, one hundred dollars (\$100.00), and
20 renewal thereof, fifty dollars (\$50.00). All fees shall be paid before any applicant may
21 be admitted to examination or his name placed upon the register of pharmacists or
22 before any license or permit, or any renewal thereof, may be issued by the Board."

23 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to fees due after that
24 date.
