Short Title: Def. Repair/Sanitary Sewage.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DEFINE THE TERM "REPAIR" AS USED IN RELATION TO THE
REGULATION OF SANITARY SEWAGE SYSTEMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 130A-334 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(9a) 'Repair' means the expansion, alteration, or relocation of existing components of a system for sewage collection, treatment, and disposal when such expansion, alteration, or relocation does not comply with an improvement permit, certificate of completion, or operating permit issued pursuant to this Article or does not comply with this Article or rules adopted pursuant to this Article. 'Repair' does not include the replacement of broken pipes, cleaning, or adjustment of an existing system components or appurtenances."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
