A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND THE FINANCING,
2 WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF CERTAIN
3 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT
4 INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND THE
5 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA HOSPITALS AT CHAPEL HILL.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. The purpose of this act is to authorize construction, by certain
9 constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and the University of North
10 Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill, of the capital improvements projects listed herein for
11 each institution, and to authorize the financing of these said capital improvements
12 projects with funds available to the institutions and the Hospitals from gifts, grants,
13 receipts, self-liquidating indebtedness, or other funds, or any combination of such funds,
14 but not including funds appropriated from the General Fund of the State.

15 Sec. 2. The projects hereby authorized to be constructed and financed as
16 provided in Section 1 of this act are as follows:

18 Sec. 3. At the request of The University of North Carolina Board of
19 Governors and upon determining that it is in the best interest of the State to do so, the
20 Director of the Budget may authorize an increase or decrease in the scope of or a change
21 in the method of funding for any project authorized by this act. In making a
22 determination of whether to authorize a change in scope or funding, the Director of the
23 Budget may consult with the Advisory Budget Commission. In no event may
24 appropriations from the General Fund be used for a project authorized by this act.

25 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
