A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWNS OF MATTHEWS, MINT HILL, AND  
2 PINEVILLE IN MECKLENBURG COUNTY TO REGULATE IN CERTAIN  
3 EXTRATERRITORIAL AREAS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Notwithstanding Section 12 of Chapter 860 of the 1971 Session  
7 Laws, the Towns of Matthews, Mint Hill, and Pineville may exercise the powers  
8 granted by Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes within extraterritorial  
9 areas in Mecklenburg County not to exceed one mile of their respective corporate limits,  
10 subject to the limitations set forth in this act.

11 Sec. 2. Any exercise of the authority granted by this act shall be  
12 accomplished in accordance with G.S. 160A-360, except that no approval from  
13 Mecklenburg County is required prior to such exercise.

14 Sec. 3. This act authorizes the exercise of extraterritorial jurisdiction only in  
15 those areas that may be annexed by each town, as set forth in and referred to as the  
16 "Sphere of Influence" in annexation agreements entered into by the Towns of Matthews,  
17 Mint Hill, and Pineville, respectively, and the City of Charlotte. The area in which the  
18 extraterritorial jurisdiction authorized by this act is to be exercised shall be specifically  
19 identified in an ordinance as required by G.S. 160A-360, and may be changed from time  
20 to time in the same manner, in accordance with the above-referenced agreement,  
21 modifications thereto, or future agreements or changed circumstances delineating areas  
22 in which the towns may annex.

23 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
