A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE LAWS RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES
APPLY WITHIN THE SEVEN LAKES COMMUNITY IN MOORE COUNTY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The provisions of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes relating to the use of the highways of the State and the operation of motor vehicles are applicable to the streets, roadways, alleys, and driveways on the properties owned by or under the control of the Seven Lakes Landowners Association, Inc., or the members of the Seven Lakes Landowners Association, Inc. A violation of any of those laws is punishable as prescribed by those laws.

Sec. 2. This act is enforceable by any company policeman appointed under Chapter 74A of the General Statutes, certified by the North Carolina Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission, and employed by the Seven Lakes Landowners Association, Inc.

Sec. 3. This act shall not be construed as in any way interfering with the ownership and control of the streets, roadways, alleys, and driveways of the Seven Lakes Landowners Association, Inc., or its members as is now vested by law in that association or its members.

Sec. 4. This act applies only to Moore County.

Sec. 5. This act is effective upon ratification.
