Section 1. (a) Offense. – A person commits the offense of third degree trespass if	,
without written authorization, he enters or remains on the premises of another for the	3
purpose of hunting, fishing, trapping, or operating an all terrain vehicle.	
(b) Classification. – Third degree trespass is a misdemeanor punishable by	/
imprisonment for up to 30 days, a fine up to two hundred dollars (\$200.00), or both.	
Sec. 2. This act applies only to Davidson County.	
Sec. 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991, and applies to offenses	3
committed on or after that date.
