2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE BEDDING SANITATION LAW.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 Section 1. G.S. 130A-261(1) reads as rewritten:

5 "(1) 'Bedding' means any mattress, upholstered spring, sleeping bag, pad,
6 comforter, cushion, pillow, decorative pillow, and any other padded or
7 stuffed item designed to be or commonly used principally for reclining
8 or sleeping. This definition includes only those items which have a
9 thickness of more than one inch.—This definition also includes dual
10 purpose furniture such as studio couches and sofa beds. The term
11 'mattress' does not include water bed liners, bladders or cylinders ~~but~~
12 ~~does include padding or cushioning material which has a thickness of~~
13 ~~more than one inch unless they contain padding or stuffing."~~

14 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1992.
