A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES FOR TRACKING NEWBORN INFANTS SCREENED FOR SICKLE CELL ANEMIA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of \$20,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$20,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to provide funding to the community-based Sickle Cell Centers for the tracking of infants screened for sickle cell anemia in the newborn screening program.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
