A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT PERSONS WHO DERIVE A SIGNIFICANT
2 PORTION OF THEIR INCOME FROM DEVELOPMENT-RELATED BUSINESS
3 ACTIVITIES MAY NOT BE APPOINTED AS AT-LARGE MEMBERS OF THE
4 COASTAL RESOURCES COMMISSION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 113A-104(c) reads as rewritten:

8 "♦(c) Appointment of Members. – Appointments to the Commission shall be made
9 to provide knowledge and experience in a diverse range of coastal interests. The
10 members of the Commission shall serve and act on the Commission solely for the best
11 interests of the public and public trust, and shall bring their particular knowledge and
12 experience to the Commission for that end alone.

13 The Governor shall appoint in his sole discretion those members of the Commission
14 whose qualifications are described in subdivisions (6) and (10), and one of the three
15 members described in subdivision (12) of subsection (b) of this section.

16 The remaining members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Governor after
17 completion of the nominating procedures prescribed by subsection (d) of this
18 section. The members of the Commission whose qualifications are described in
19 subdivisions (1) through (5), (9), ~~and (11)~~, and (12), shall be persons who do not derive
20 any significant portion of their income from land development, construction, real estate
21 sales, or lobbying and do not otherwise serve as agents for development-related
22 business activities. The Governor shall require adequate disclosure of potential
23 conflicts of interest by members. The Governor, by executive order, shall promulgate

1 criteria regarding conflicts of interest and disclosure thereof for determining the
2 eligibility of persons under this section."

3 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to appointments of
4 at-large members made on or after that date.
