A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE A GRACE PERIOD FOR PLUMBING AND HEATING
CONTRACTORS ELIGIBLE TO OBTAIN A LICENSE WITHOUT
EXAMINATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 87-21 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(d1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, any resident of the State who was engaged in the business as defined in this Article for at least five years prior to July 6, 1971, in any city, town, or other area in which this Article previously did not apply, and who has continued to engage in the business to the time of application, shall receive a license without examination upon submission of an application and license application fee, together with proof that he was engaged in the business during the time set forth herein."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and expires on December 31, 1991.
