A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT PRESCRIPTION DRUG LABELS CONTAIN THE  
EXPIRATION DATE OF THE MEDICATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 90-85.29 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 90-85.29. Prescription label.**

The prescription label of every drug product dispensed shall contain the brand name of any drug product dispensed, or in the absence of a brand name, the established name. The prescription label of every drug product dispensed shall also contain the expiration date of the drug product being dispensed."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1992.
