Short Title: Drivers License Suspension Period.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE A PERSON TO BE CONVICTED DURING THE PERIOD
OF DRIVERS LICENSE SUSPENSION FOR AN ACT COMMITTED DURING
THAT PERIOD BEFORE THAT PERIOD MAY BE LENGTHENED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-28.1(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Upon receipt of notice of conviction of any person of a motor vehicle moving offense, such offense having been committed and the person convicted while such person's driving privilege was in a state of suspension or revocation, the Division shall revoke such person's driving privilege for an additional period of time as set forth in subsection (b) hereof."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
