A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PROGRAM AT SUMMIT HOUSE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year to support the program at Summit House, a community-based residential alternative to incarceration for mothers and pregnant women convicted of nonviolent crimes. Summit House shall report quarterly to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the expenditure of State appropriations and on the effectiveness of the program, including information on the number of clients served, the services provided to each client, and the status of each client upon release from the program.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
