A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A FOX TRAPPING SEASON IN CASWELL COUNTY.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open
season for taking foxes with rubber cleat traps from January 31 through June 30 of each
year.
Sec. 2. A season bag limit of 30 applies to all foxes taken during the trapping
season established in this act.
Sec. 3. The Wildlife Resources Commission shall provide for the sale of
foxes taken lawfully pursuant to this act.
Sec. 4. This act applies only to Caswell County.
Sec. 5. This act shall become effective October 1, 1992.
