AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE GOVERNOR'S WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANTS TO SITE DESIGNATION REVIEW COMMITTEES IN THE THREE COUNTIES SELECTED FOR CHARACTERIZATION STUDIES FOR THE LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITY AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT SELECT COMMITTEE ON LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Governor's Waste Management Board in the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year. The Governor's Waste Management Board shall use the funds appropriated by this act to make technical assistance grants of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) each to the Richmond County Site Designation Review Committee, the Chatham County Site Designation Review Committee, and the Wake County Site Designation Review Committee established pursuant to G.S. 104G-19. The provisions of G.S. 104G-19 shall apply to grants made pursuant to this act except that the limits on the amount of technical assistance grants set out in G.S.104G-19(d) shall not apply to grants made pursuant to this act.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective 1 July 1992.
