**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO NAME THE NEW REVENUE BUILDING AND TO MAKE AN  
APPROPRIATION FOR THE BUILDING'S SIGNAGE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding G.S. 100-8, 143B-373, and 147-17, the building known as the new Revenue Building on Wilmington Street in Raleigh shall be named the Kenneth C. Royall, Junior, Revenue Building.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated for Fiscal Year 1992-1993 from the General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to be used for exterior signage for the Kenneth C. Royall, Junior, Revenue Building.

Sec. 3. This act is effective July 1, 1993.
