1 AN ACT TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT A PERSON BE A RESIDENT
2 OF THE STATE IN ORDER TO OBTAIN A HUNTING AND FISHING GUIDE
3 LICENSE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 113-270.4(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) No one may serve for hire as a hunting or fishing guide without having first
8 procured a current and valid hunting and fishing guide license. This license is valid
9 only for use by an individual ~~resident of the State~~ meeting the criteria set by the Wildlife
10 Resources Commission for issuance of the license. Possession of the hunting and
11 fishing guide license does not relieve the guide from meeting other applicable license
12 requirements."

13 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
