A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE STATE AGENCIES STUDY HOW BEST TO
2 COORDINATE STATE AGENCIES' PROGRAMS AND SERVICES FOR THE
3 HOMELESS.
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5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The Department of Human Resources, the Department of
7 Economic and Community Development, the Housing Finance Agency, the Department
8 of Public Instruction, and all other affected State agencies, shall collaborate in a study of
9 how best to coordinate State-level programs and services for the homeless, including
10 McKinney programs. This study shall include recommendations as to which agency
11 should have the central State role, as to whether a State position of coordinator of
12 programs and services is needed and, if so, where to place the position, as to what
13 statutes need changing, if any, and as to what additional legislative action needs to be
14 taken to effect proper coordination.

15 Sec. 2. The Departments and other State agencies performing the study shall
16 consult with the local public and private agencies and individuals providing services and
17 programs for the homeless.

18 Sec. 3. The study required by this act shall be presented to the Legislative
19 Research Commission's Study Committee on Homeless Persons, if reauthorized, the
20 Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations, and to the Fiscal Research
21 Division, by October 31, 1991.

22 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
