1                                   A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR  
3 COSMETOLOGY TEACHERS AND TO REQUIRE ADEQUATE  
4 VENTILATION IN SHOPS AND SCHOOLS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6       Section 1. G.S. 88-23(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "**§ 88-23. Rules and regulations of Board; inspections; granting of certificates to**  
8 **Board members; employment of former Board members.**

9       (a)           (1)     The State Board of Cosmetic Art Examiners shall have the  
10                   authority to make a reasonable curriculum and rules for recognized  
11                   schools and colleges of beauty culture and make reasonable rules  
12                   and regulations for the sanitary management of cosmetic art shops,  
13                   beauty parlors, hairdressing establishments, cosmetic art schools,  
14                   colleges, academies and training schools, hereinafter called shops  
15                   and schools, and to have such curriculum and rules and the sanitary  
16                   rules and regulations enforced. The duly authorized agents of said  
17                   Board shall have authority to enter upon and inspect any shop or  
18                   school at any time during business hours. A copy of the curriculum  
19                   and rules and the sanitary rules and regulations shall be furnished  
20                   from the office of the Board or by the above mentioned authorized  
21                   agents to the owner or manager of each shop or school in the State,  
22                   and such copy shall be kept posted in a conspicuous place in each  
23                   shop and school, and a copy of the curriculum and rules for

- 1 recognized schools and colleges of beauty culture shall be kept  
2 posted in a conspicuous place in each school and the rules and  
3 regulations complied with as required by this Chapter.
- 4 (2) The Board shall adopt regulations prohibiting the use of commercial  
5 chemicals of unknown content by persons registered under this  
6 Chapter. For purposes of this section, 'commercial chemicals' are  
7 those products sold only through beauty and barber supply houses and  
8 not available to the general public.
- 9 (3) The Board shall adopt regulations instructing persons registered under  
10 this Chapter in the proper use and application of commercial chemicals  
11 where no manufacturer's instructions are included. In the alternative,  
12 the Board shall prohibit the use of such commercial chemicals by  
13 persons registered under this Chapter.
- 14 (4) The Board shall adopt regulations requiring that cosmetology teachers  
15 complete a minimum of 16 hours of continuing education every two  
16 years. Effective October 1, 1993, the Board shall not renew the license  
17 of any cosmetology teacher who has not satisfied the continuing  
18 education requirements established by the Board.
- 19 (5) The Board shall adopt regulations requiring that adequate ventilation  
20 for the protection of the public be maintained in places where cosmetic  
21 art is practiced or taught. Regulations adopted under this subdivision  
22 shall be enforced no earlier than October 1, 1992."
- 23 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
