A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT COMPLIANCE WITH CHILD SUPPORT
GUIDELINES IS A SUFFICIENT CHANGE OF CIRCUMSTANCES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 50-13.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) An order of a court of this State for support of a minor child may be modified or vacated at any time, upon motion in the cause and either a showing of changed circumstances or upon a showing of change in the application of the child support guidelines by either party or anyone interested subject to the limitations of G.S. 50-13.10. Subject to the provisions of G.S. 50A-3, an order of a court of this State for custody of a minor child may be modified or vacated at any time, upon motion in the cause and a showing of changed circumstances by either party or anyone interested."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
