A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO PERMIT NEW HANOVER COUNTY TO PROVIDE PROCEDURES
FOR EVALUATING CONTRACTORS BY ORDINANCE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of New Hanover County may, by ordinance, provide procedures for evaluating the work performed by construction contractors on County capital improvement projects and the Board of County Commissioners may use the evaluations as a factor in determining qualification of contractors to bid on County capital improvement projects or may use the evaluations as one of the factors in determining the lowest responsible bidder or bidders pursuant to G.S. 143-129. If the ordinance provides that the evaluations are to be used to determine the lowest responsible bidder or bidders the ordinance shall provide for a public hearing at least 10 days prior to the award of any contract to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
