A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEM AT
PIEDMONT TRIAD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Piedmont Triad Airport Authority the sum of \$9,500,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year for a fire suppression system at Piedmont Triad International Airport.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective the later of (i) July 1, 1991, or (ii) the first day of the first month after the date United Air Lines, Inc., locates an aircraft maintenance facility at Piedmont Triad International Airport. After United Air Lines, Inc., locates an aircraft maintenance facility at Piedmont Triad International Airport, the Piedmont Triad Airport Authority shall immediately certify to the Office of State Budget and Management the date the facility was located at the airport.
