1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE SUPPLEMENTAL PAY TO STATE EMPLOYEES AND
3	PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE BEEN CALLED TO ACTIVE
4	MILITARY DUTY.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State shall
7	provide supplemental pay, up to the amount of the person's monthly salary, to any:
8	(1) State officer or employee; or
9	(2) Employee of a local school administrative unit paid wholly or partly
10	with State funds
11	who has been called to a period of extended active military duty by order of the
12	President of the United States. No such officer or employee shall receive an amount of
13	supplemental pay that, added to his military compensation, would exceed the amount of
14	his State pay had the officer or employee not been called to active military duty.
15	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and shall apply to all employees
16	described in Section 1 of this act who have been called to extended active military duty
17	since August 2, 1990, but no payments shall be made under this act on account of

18 military duty after June 30, 1992.
