A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REMOVE THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA LICENSURE  
REQUIREMENTS FROM OUT-OF-STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION OPERATING ON MILITARY BASES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 116-15(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Post-secondary Degree Activity within the Military. – To the extent that an institution undertakes post-secondary degree activity on the premises of military posts or reservations located in this ~~State~~ State, ~~for military personnel stationed on active duty there, or their dependents~~, the institution shall be exempt from the licensure requirements of this section."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
