A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO EQUIP AND DESIGN, CONSTRUCT,
AND INSTALL EXHIBITIONS IN THE NEW NORTH CAROLINA MUSEUM
OF HISTORY BUILDING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources, Division of Archives and History, the sum of \$4,215,800 for the 1991-92 fiscal year for capital improvements at the new North Carolina Museum of History building, which include purchasing and installing security and communication systems; equipping the education complex, auditorium, public and staff areas, the design studio, and the exhibition construction shop; designing, constructing, and installing 30,000 square feet of exhibitions, including carpet and display lights; and purchasing and installing collection storage systems.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
