April 30, 1991 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN ANNUAL ALLOWANCE OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY 3 DOLLARS TO EACH MEMBER OF THE NORTH CAROLINA NATIONAL 4 GUARD. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 127A-139 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 6 "(a1) There shall be allowed each year to every member of the North Carolina 7 National Guard who has served for nine months or more the sum of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00). This allowance shall be paid on July 1 each year from funds 9 appropriated to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety for that purpose. A 10 member may not receive the allowance provided in this subsection unless he has performed satisfactorily all duties required of him by law and regulations and has 12 pursued such course of instruction as may from time to time be required." 13

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
