SENATE BILL 849

Short Title: MR/DD Services Funds.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE THE LEVEL OF FUNDING
3 FOR SERVICES FOR THE MENTALLY RETARDED/DEVELOPMENTALLY
4 DISABLED.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
7 Human Resources, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and
8 Substance Abuse Services, the sum of \$1,749,752 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the
9 sum of \$2,867,443 for the 1992-93 fiscal year, to increase the level of funding for
10 services for the mentally retarded/developmentally disabled. These funds shall be
11 allocated as follows:

12 (1) For Fiscal Year 1991-92:

- 13 a. \$1,215,000 to group homes for the developmentally disabled;
14 b. \$134,752 to existing Apartment Living Programs;
15 c. \$400,000 to cover the capital and start-up costs of new
16 Apartment Living Programs; and

17 (2) For Fiscal Year 1992-93:

- 18 a. \$2,431,095 to group homes for the developmentally disabled;
19 b. \$286,348 to Apartment Living Programs existing as of the
20 1991-92 fiscal year; and
21 c. \$150,000 for operational expenses for the group homes whose
22 capital and start-up costs were funded pursuant to sub-
23 subdivision c. of subdivision (1) of this section.

24 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
