A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO DISCOVERY PLACE FOR OPERATING  
EXPENSES.

Whereas, between 1983 and 1990, the General Assembly has funded  
Discovery Place at the level of \$250,000 per fiscal year with the exception of the 1985-  
86 fiscal year when Discovery Place received \$225,000; and

Whereas, Discovery Place did not receive an appropriation for the 1990-91  
fiscal year; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
Agriculture the sum of \$450,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$200,000  
for the 1992-93 fiscal year for operating expenses of Discovery Place. Of the funds  
appropriated for the 1991-92 fiscal year, Discovery Place may use the sum of \$250,000  
for the 1990-91 fiscal year to cover the cost of operating its educational programs for  
school children from across North Carolina.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
