April 2, 1991 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO DISCOVERY PLACE FOR OPERATING 3 EXPENSES. Whereas, between 1983 and 1990, the General Assembly has funded 4 Discovery Place at the level of \$250,000 per fiscal year with the exception of the 1985-5 86 fiscal year when Discovery Place received \$225,000; and 6 Whereas, Discovery Place did not receive an appropriation for the 1990-91 7 8 fiscal year; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 9 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 10 Agriculture the sum of \$450,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$200,000 11 for the 1992-93 fiscal year for operating expenses of Discovery Place. Of the funds 12 appropriated for the 1991-92 fiscal year, Discovery Place may use the sum of \$250,000 13 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to cover the cost of operating its educational programs for 14

school children from across North Carolina.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
